Screening of the Film "Papers" Wednesday, July 14 in Des Moines

"Papers" is the story of undocumented youth and the challenges they face as they turn 18 without legal status. There are approximately two million undocumented children who were born outside the United States and raised in this country. These are young people who were educated in American schools, hold American values, know only the United States as home and who, simply by turning 18, become "illegal" immigrants. 65,000 undocumented students graduate every year from high school without "papers" and the door to their future slams shut. It is against the law to work or drive. It is difficult, if not impossible in some states, to attend college. Currently, there is no path to citizenship for these young people.

Doors open 6:15 p.m. at Grace United Methodist Church, 3700 Cottage Grove Avenue, Des Moines. The screening begins at 6:30 p.m. A discussion of the Iowa Act with Marshalltown youth will follow the movie.
