Welcome to "Holy Humor" Sunday! Please enjoy the lighthearted, back to front twist on worship and the ways we express our faith today. No offense or disrespect is intended and our sincere faith underlies our worship today, as it does every Sunday! Today's Holy Humor Sunday has it's roots in history. For centuries, in Catholic, Orthodox, and Protestant countries, Easter Monday and "Bright Sunday (the Sunday after Easter) were observed by the faithful as "days of joy and laughter" with parties and picnics to celebrate Jesus' resurrection. Parishioners and pastors played practical jokes on each other, drenched each other with water, sang, and danced. It was a time for clergy and people to tell jokes and to have fun. The custom of Easter Monday and Bright Sunday celebrations were rooted in the musings of early church theologians (like Augustine, Gregory of Nyssa, and John Chrysostom) that God played a practical joke on the devil by raising Jesus from the dead. Easter was God's supreme joke played on death. "Risus paschalis " the Easter laugh," the early theologians called it. Let the joy begin!
