If God should mark wrongdoings, who could stand? But there is forgiveness with God, so that God may be revered.


We wait for our God, our souls wait, and in God's word we hope; our souls wait for God more than those who watch for the morning, more than those who watch for the morning.





"All Who Hunger, Gather Gladly" v. 3


